




## ASI – MSEL problem

MSEL and BOLG proposed ECGN station by Univ. Bologna (Zerbini).

1. Oct 6, [LAC mail](#) : New EPN station in Italy: MSEL (inquiry for ACs - ASI, BKG, DEO and BEK)
2. Oct 6, [EUREF mail](#) : Angry mail from Vespe (ASI) – concerning both MSEL and BOLG (?) – both located at MEDI
3. Oct 7, [EUREF mail](#) : Official announcement of MSEL as EPN station – ECGN station
4. Oct 7, [Mail from Vespe](#) with complaints about ASI treatment within EUREF
5. Oct 8, [Reply from Carine](#) to Vespe, after consultation with Altamimi and Ihde
6. Oct 8, [Reply from Vespe](#) to mail above
7. Oct 11, [EUREF mail](#) : Reply Zerbini to mail from Vespe

# EPN stations at the same site



Commitment letter required (5 years)

Exceptions to 300 km rule also possible for timing stations, stations collocated with tide gauges, GPS/GLONASS stations

IGS stations in Europe no longer automatically part of EPN

300 km distance between new and existing EPN station necessary, exceptions :

- stations submitting hourly data
- stations contributing to EPN Special Project

IGS stations in Europe automatically part of the EPN
