  - Action Item TWG-43-06: Document defining EUREF-INSPIRE relationship to be compiled (?)
- 25 April 2007:
  - Publication of INSPIRE directive in Official Journal of EU
- 15 May 2007:
  - The INSPIRE directive entered into force
  - DT Data Specifications: Call for comments on the Definition of Annex Themes and Scope D2.3 (117 pages)
  - DT Data Specifications: Call for comments on the Generic Conceptual model D2.5 (93 pages)



## Status Notes

- **29 June 2007:** 
  - EUREF submitted comments on D2.3 (2 comments) and D2.5 (13 comments)
- 4 September 2007:
  - Call for Expression of Interest for development of data specifications:
    - To submit candidate specifications (scenario 1)
    - ❖ To participate in specification development (scenario 2)



## Status Notes

- 13 14 September 2007:
  - Comments resolution workshop in Ispra
- 27 September 2007:
  - EUREF nominated 3 experts for scenario 2 of CfEI from September 4
  - J. Torres, A. Caporali, H. Habrich
- **23 24 October 2007:** 
  - H. Habrich participated in DT DS meeting in Berlin
  - Comments resolutions could not be finalized in Ispra and discussion was continued in Berlin



# Implementing Rules Development

Preferences: Scenario  $1 \rightarrow 2 \rightarrow 3$ 

#### Scenario 1:

- An SDIC/LMO submits a complete specification for one particular "Annex I - III" theme
- Status: "No or only few qualified proposals received"


#### Scenario 2:

- An SDIC/LMO proposes experts for working in one or several Thematic Working Groups (TWGs)
- Status: "Sufficient experts for all Annex Themes nominated"

#### Scenario 3:

External experts or projects, e.g., eContenPlus programs, are involved





# News (16 November 2007)

- E-Mail Katalin Toth, EC Joint Research Centre (JRC), Ispra
- "TWG" kick-off meeting will be held in Ispra on 14 –15 February 2008
- Scenario 2 will apply for all Annex I themes except the Geographical Grids ("TWG" for CRS will be set up)
- An editor and a facilitator should be added to each TWG
- The role of editor will be solved using the in-house resources of JRC: Two colleagues with appropriate UML expertise will do this job.
- Concerning the facilitator JRC will launch a tender with a budget of 25K Euro for each theme
- Decision about TWG members pending
  - 26 November 2007: H. Habrich was asked to confirm availability for participation in TWG for CRS
