

## EUREF best student poster award

### Introduction

Dr. Carl Calvert created in 2007 an award to stimulate the research on topics covered by the IAG Reference Frame Sub-commission for Europe - EUREF and give the opportunity to students to present their work.

EUREF will offer each year a "Best Student Poster Award" at the annual EUREF symposia.

The award consists on a certificate and a monetary prize of 100 €.

### Eligibility

To be eligible for an award, applicants must:

- Be the first author on a poster submission
- Be a full-time graduate student at the time of submission
- Present their poster research at the EUREF symposia

### Award Criteria

The winner is selected by a Jury according to the following major criteria

1. Scientific quality
2. Quality, structure and organization of the poster presentation

### Jury

The Jury is formed by members of the EUREF Technical Working Group (TWG).

The Jury will present their proposal at the TWG spring meeting before the symposium for approval.

The winner will be announced immediately after the meeting that usually occurs 3 months before the symposium.

### Application

The candidates must send their poster presentations 1 month before the TWG spring meeting to the address that will be posted at the Symposium website.
