- Placemarks for each campaign
- Within tag reference to further information (application paper, SINEX files etc., if submitted)
- Some special campaigns (EUREF 89, EUVN97, Balkan campaign) with different placemarkers
- One page for accepted campaigns, one for campaigns to be accepted (also playing grounds for info extraction, like tables



### Deliverables



- Campaigns before 2007 delivered only (not always)
- Report
- Station info concerning names, coordinates, accuracies
- Information may be lost
- Campaigns since 2009 should deliver
- Report
- Site description (station logs)
- SINEX file of coordinates, free network and minimally constrained
- Coordinate and velocity (if applicable) list in ITRF
- Coordinate and velocity (if applicable) list in ETRF
- Fiducial sites with coordinates and velocities used



## Discussion about Necessity



- No request by EUREF for public use of sites anymore
- No limitations of the number of sites by EUREF anymore
- Metadata may not be delivered from private sites (Czech campaign), reducing information to site name and equipment
- EUREF site information will be updated at no time, concerning equipment and behaviour
- Is it useful to repeat the site information outside the report?
- The validation of campaigns by EUREF is restricted to the procedure only, no site information would be necessary therefore
- Proposals:
- Drop the deliverable Site Description in the guidelines
- No EUREF database for sites, publish the digital reports
