Resolution No. 1

The IAG Subcommission for Europe (EUREF)

recognizing the availability of good quality GPS results from the EUREF Permanent GPS Network

proposes to the IERS to include the EUREF Permanent GPS Network solutions into the annual ITRS realisations.

Resolution No. 2

The IAG Subcommission for Europe (EUREF)

recognising the success of the experimental phase of the EUREF Permanent GPS Network

urges the EUREF Technical Working Group (TWG) to call for participation in taking the network from an experimental to an operational status

invites participating agencies and other interested parties to respond positively to this call.

Resolution No. 3

The IAG Subcommission for Europe (EUREF)

recognizing that the accepted results of EUREF campaigns, containing all coordinate realisations of EUREF markers have been published and incorporated into a database

intends to make this database available free of charge on the Internet with effect from 1. 1. 1998

invites National Agencies to review the data.

Resolution No. 4

The IAG Subcommission for Europe (EUREF)

recognising the need for the use of archival levelling data to be combined with current and future height determination

asks the national agencies to identify a National Centre for this purpose

and urges scientific institutions to develop combined models for kinematic height systems.

Resolution No. 5
