### Geodetic work in the last year

- Continued development and planning for release of the new height model for Ireland, OSVRF10.
- Continued data contribution to:
  - EPN Permanent GNSS Network (Stations BELF, ENIS, FOYL)
  - EPN Real-Time Analysis (Station BELF)
  - Met Office UK (EUMETNET E-GVAP)
  - British Isles GPS Archive facility BIGF (hosted by IESSG at the University of Nottingham)
  - Any NI Government department as part of NIMA



### Planned 2014/15 Developments

- Implementation of the new OSVRF10 height model to replace OSGM02 as the approved method of determining Orthometric heights in Northern Ireland wrt Belfast Datum
- Implementation of the EUREF IE/UK 2009 campaign realisation of ETRS89 as the official positioning framework in Northern Ireland
- Installation of a further GNSS station to densify the network
- Replacement of the GNSS network operating software



## Planned 2014/15 Developments

• Installation of IP cameras at all active stations to assist with Photogrammetry flying program.
