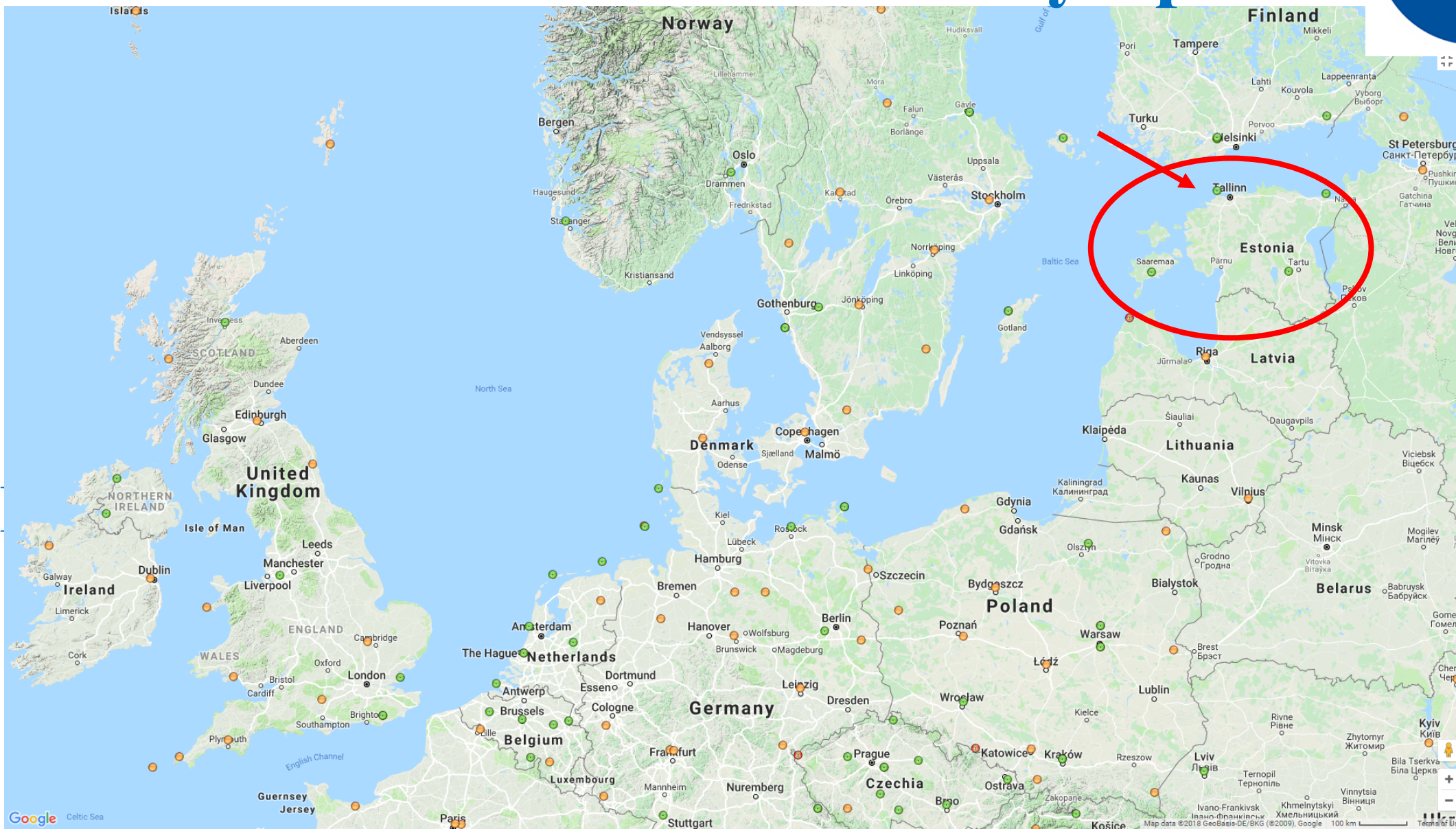




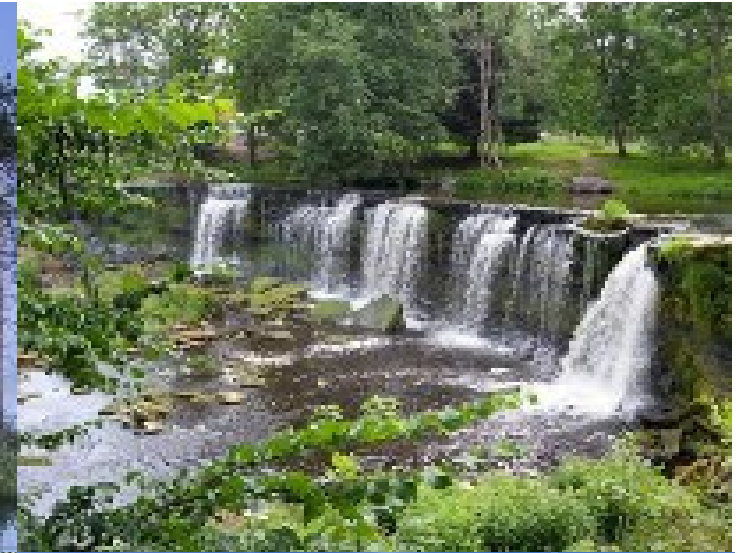

- Area: 45 339 km²
- Population: 1.316 million
- Forests cover ca 55%
 - Highest point: 318 m
 - 1521 islands
 - Thousands of lakes
- e-Estonia = advanced digital society
