- Submission of BFST rock anchored station to EPN replacing destroyed BELF station.
- Densification of the Network with a new GNSS station in Killough, Co.Down (KILL)
- Continuation of Gravity Project in partnership with OSi and IGiK
- ENIS EPN station – investigation of movement
- Provide support for Ordnance Survey data capture
