

EUREF 2022 Resolutions

Resolution No. 1.

The IAG Reference Frame Sub-commission for Europe (EUREF)

recognising that the multi-year solution for the Slovakian SKPOS network was completed and presented to the EUREF Governing Board (GB) by representatives of Slovakia and that these results were accepted by the GB as Class A standard

endorses the set of points for Slovakia, as submitted to the GB, as a national realisation of ETRS89

Resolution No. 2.

The IAG Reference Frame Sub-commission for Europe (EUREF)

considering the sudden and long-standing outage of one of the GNSS Data Centres supporting the activities of the EUREF Permanent Network (EPN)

and noting the reduced number of GNSS stations available during the outage

asks the EPN station managers and the Analysis Centres to upload the observation data and products in parallel to both EPN Regional Data Centres as well as the users to balance their downloads across all of the EPN Data Centres

Resolution No. 3.

The IAG Reference Frame Sub-commission for Europe (EUREF)

considering that the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) imposes limitations on the use of personal data

and noting the need to ensure sustainable contact information of all EPN components

urges all contributors to the EUREF Permanent GNSS Network to use neutral, non personally-identifiable contact details in all metadata, data, and products submitted to EUREF that are intended for public distribution

Resolution No. 4.

The IAG Reference Frame Sub-commission for Europe (EUREF)

noting that with the release of the ITRF2020 and the upcoming IGS20 as the new reference frame for GNSS operational services, inconsistencies between the products of the past and the future analysis cannot be avoided

and considering that there is a need for consistent EPN products such as coordinates, velocities and tropospheric parameters for the entire history of the EPN

encourages the EPN Reprocessing Working Group to start a third reanalysis of the EPN data in order to provide a long time span of consistent products

and recommends paying particular attention to ensuring consistency between operational and reprocessed products by maintaining homogeneous processing strategies
